Admission and participation are free! Pick up your Beavers in the City kits at:



This is your **Beavers in the City** activity kit. Inside you will find:

- A family pass to the Canadian Museum of Nature
- A family pass to the Currency Museum
- A map of Ottawa
- An activity sheet
- Activity Clue #1
- Five trade tokens
- A survey

Note: Remember to be careful when crossing any streets during this activity.

Begin by visiting the special **Beaver Interpretation Station** at either the Canadian Museum of Nature or the Currency Museum, and then use the map of Ottawa to help you find your way along the outdoor **Beaver Trade Route**.

Start with **Activity Clue #1** (in your kit), and be on the lookout for friendly beavers who will identify the **Beaver Trading Stations** along the route. Once you have found a **Trading Station**, exchange one of your trade tokens for the next activity clue, and so on. You have five trade tokens, and there are five **Beaver Trading Stations** along the route to your final destination (one of the two participating museums, depending on where you started). Hand in your completed activity sheet at the front desk and your family will be eligible to win a prize! Finally, we would appreciate it if you would take the time to fill out the enclosed survey.

Thank you for helping us to celebrate one of Canada's best-known national symbols – the beaver. Have a great Canada Day!
