Accommodations

Conference Hotel

The Rodd Marina Inn and Suites is the Summer Institute host hotel. This charming hotel is located in the picturesque Town of Montague. Nestled along the banks of the Montague River, guests will enjoy captivating views of the river and Montague's waterfront. The Addictions Research Centre, where the Summer Institute will be held, is less than a five-minute walk away. The hotel offers both standard and suite accommodation with a complimentary deluxe breakfast included. Participants are responsible for making their own accommodation arrangements. It is advisable to make reservations as soon as possible to get the preferred rate of \$110 Cdn (for standard guestroom) and \$130 Cdn (for suite) and to guarantee room availability.
