Online Application Form Overview

This is a preview of what you'll find on the online application form. We recommend that you gather the information for these questions (whether you are the nominee or you're nominating someone else) and work through a rough draft. It will save you time later on when you answer these questions on the official online application form.

Who are you nominating?

We'll be asking for complete contact information for the nominee and anyone who nominates. Full name, mailing address with postal code, phone numbers (for day and evening), e-mail address, employer's name or business and job title.

Tell us about the nominee

In this section we want to get to know the nominee a little better. Tell us the nominee's story (where she grew up, went to school – just information that could be shared at a barbecue with friends).

What does the nominee love most about Canadian agriculture?

In this section we want to hear what makes the nominee passionate about Canadian agriculture and how she shares or demonstrates her passion.

Who could we call for references?

We'll need a full name and phone numbers (day and evening).

The short essay

In no less than 500 words, tell us:

- How is the nominee involved in Canadian agriculture?
- How does the nominee demonstrate a passion for and commitment to agriculture?
- How does the nominee "give back" to agriculture? Is it through volunteerism or leadership?
- What impact has the nominee's leadership had in agriculture?
- What new ideas or innovative thinking has the nominee used that you think helps her be successful? (Does she work with other innovators or forward-thinking groups? Or has she found a new way to promote agriculture or help other women?)
