Victoria Steele Managing Director, English Theatre

Victoria Steele is Managing Director of English language theatre at Canada's National Arts Centre (NAC). Ms. Steele has worked for 25 years in Canadian theatre management including the past 13 at the NAC. She is responsible for managing the business aspects of NAC English Theatre activities working in partnership with Artistic Director Marti Maraden. Prior to arriving at the NAC, Ms. Steele was General Manager of Muskoka Festival Theatre and Toronto's Adelaide Court Theatre. She also held management positions with Toronto's Young People's Theatre and London, Ontario's Grand Theatre and has had numerous consulting contracts.

Ms. Steele has continually been active in the national arts community having served in senior positions on the Boards of Directors of CAPACOA (Canadian Arts Presenting Association), the new national Magnetic North Theatre Festival, the Federal Cultural Trade Advisory Board, the Professional Association of Canadian Theatres, Le Théâtre français de Toronto, the Association of Cultural Executives (ACE) and the Association of Summer Theatres in Ontario. She also chaired the 1992 Cultural Imperative III: national arts management conference for ACE and was on the Steering Committee of the 2002 national Canadian Theatre Conference.

Ms. Steele is a graduate of Queens University's School of Business and Drama Department. She is also a past recipient of the Wm.Wylie and Victor Polley Awards in arts administration.
