From 1982 to 1995, he held successively the positions of Technical Director and Assistant Producer at the NAC. Mr. Dozois has worked with a number of internationally renowned cultural organizations and choreographers, including Groupe Nouvel-Aire, Les Ballets jazz de Montréal, and Les Grands Ballets Canadiens. From 1967 to 1972, Mr. Dozois danced with Atelier Dychotomique de Montréal and Groupe Nouvel-Aire. He received his training in dance, theatre, and music with Maurice Béjart at the MUDRA School in Brussels.
