Environmental Appeals Board Hearing Schedule

The Environmental Appeals Board will hold the continuation of the hearing commenced July 21, 2005 on August 10, 2005, at the Bonnyville Circuit Court commencing at 1:00 p.m. The Hearing is in relation to Alberta Environment's decision to issue *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* Approval 204916-00-00 to CCS Inc. for the construction, operation, and reclamation of the Bonnyville Waste Management Facility in Bonnyville.

On July 21, 2005, the Board heard evidence from the parties on the following issues:

- 1. What effect, if any, will Approval No. 204916-00-00 issued to CCS Inc. for the construction, operation, and reclamation of the Bonnyville Waste Management Facility have on air quality; water quality; surface runoff; drainage; groundwater; wildlife and wildlife crossings; health; and noise?
- 2. What additional monitoring, if any, is required of the Bonnyville Waste Management Facility?

At the continuation of the Hearing on August 10, 2005, the Board will hear closing arguments from the parties.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.
