Environmental Appeals Board Hearing Schedule

The Environmental Appeals Board will hold a Hearing on September 9, 2005, in Lethbridge, Alberta, to hear submissions with respect to the decision of Alberta Environment to issue Environmental Protection Order No. 2005/11-SR to Walter Construction Corporation in relation to the reclamation of a sand and gravel pit within SE 1/4 10-7-29-W4M near Pincher Creek, Alberta.

The Environmental Appeals Board is a separate and independent body that reviews certain decisions made by Alberta Environment. The Board is composed of environmental experts from a variety of disciplines.

Any person, other than the parties, who wishes to make a representation before the Board on this appeal must submit a request in writing by fax to the Board at the fax number set out below on or before August 12, 2005. The request shall contain the name, address, telephone and fax numbers of the person submitting the request, indicate whether the person will be represented by a lawyer or agent, and if so, their name, contain a summary of the nature of the person's interest in this appeal, and be signed by the person submitting the request. After August 12, 2005, the Board will, in its discretion, determine if other persons may make representations and the manner in which they can be made.

Copies of material filed with the Board respecting this appeal will be available for viewing at the Pincher Creek Public Library during its normal operating hours, or by appointment at the Office of the Environmental Appeals Board in Edmonton.

Once all parties have been determined, the Hearing will be open to the public for viewing only.
