TO: ALL AUTOMOBILE INSURERS LICENSED IN ALBERTA

SUBJECT: SURCHARGING FOR MINOR CONVICTIONS

(See Board Circular 1-88)

in August 1988, the Board directed that among minor convictions, insurers consider only moving traffic violations in determining applicable surcharges. A question was posed to the Board on the handling of the charge of driving without a valid licence, in light of that directive.

Driving without a subsisting licence is not a moving violation. Insurers must not consider convictions under Section 5(1) of the <u>Motor Vehicle Administration Act</u> in assessing surcharges.
