POPULATION ESTIMATES

Alberta's population growth between April 1 of 2005 and 2006 continues to be the highest among all provinces. As of April 1, 2006, Alberta's population is estimated to be 3,332,225. This represents a growth of approximately 92,500 persons (or 2.85%) for the year ending April 1, 2006. British Columbia and Ontario had the next strongest growth rates among the provinces at 1.27% and 1.09% respectively.

The following table presents the population estimates and yearly growth rates for Canada and Alberta since April 1, 2002.

Population estimates for April 1, 2006 for all provinces and territories are provided in Table 2 below. The twelve-month population growth rates since April 1, 2005 are also included.

MIGRATION

During the first quarter of 2006, Alberta continued to have the largest interprovincial migration gain of 15,600 in Canada as many more people moving into than leaving Alberta.

As shown in Table 3, the primary source of Alberta's interprovincial in-migrants for the first quarter was British Columbia, followed by Ontario and Saskatchewan. These three provinces were also the main destinations of out-migrants from Alberta. (Please see cautious note at the end of Table 3 on the next page.)

NATURAL INCREASE

Between January 1 and March 31 of 2006, Alberta experienced a natural increase (births minus deaths) of approximately 5,000 people. The province had 10,100 births versus 5,100 deaths in this quarter.
