### **POPULATION ESTIMATES**

Alberta's population growth between January 1 of 2002 and 2003 remains the strongest among the provinces. As of January 1, 2003, Alberta's population is estimated to be 3,134,286. This is an increase of approximately 48,000 persons (or 1.56% growth) from January 1, 2002. Of the provinces, Ontario and British Columbia had the next largest growth rates at 1.22% and 0.85%, respectively.

The following chart shows both population estimates and growth rates of Canada and Alberta since 1998 for January 1.

Population estimates for January 1, 2003 for all provinces and territories are provided below in Table 2. Also shown is the growth rate of population between January 1, 2002 and January 1, 2003.

#### **MIGRATION**

Between October 1 and December 31, 2002, Alberta had an estimated net interprovincial migration of 3,213 people and a total net migration (interprovincial and international) of 2,889 people. Alberta had the largest number of interprovincial net migrants in Canada, followed by Quebec. The origin and destination of interprovincial migrants are shown in Table 3 on the following page.

As shown in Table 3, the primary source of Alberta's interprovincial in-migrants for the fourth quarter was British Columbia, followed by Ontario and Saskatchewan. These three provinces were also the three main destinations of out-migrants from Alberta.

#### **NATURAL INCREASE**

Statistics Canada estimates that Alberta experienced a natural increase (births minus deaths) of about 3,800 people between October 1, 2002 and December 31, 2002. More than 8,900 births occurred in this quarter, while there were an estimated 5,100 deaths.
