Statistics Canada has revised the 2001 Census figures due to undercoverage studies. Population estimates have thus been revised back to 1971, with notable changes back to 1996.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

Alberta's population growth between July 1 of 2002 and 2003 is again the strongest among the provinces. As of July 1, 2003, Alberta's population is estimated to be 3,153,723. This is an increase of approximately 39,000 persons (or 1.26% growth) from July 1, 2002. Ontario and British Columbia had the next largest growth rates among the provinces at 1.17% and 0.77% respectively.

The following chart shows both population estimates and growth rates of Canada and Alberta since 1996 for July 1.

Population estimates for July 1, 2003 for all provinces and territories are provided below in Table 2. Also shown is the growth rate of population between July 1, 2002 and July 1, 2003.

MIGRATION

Between April 1 and June 30, 2003, Alberta had an estimated net interprovincial migration of 3,046 people. This makes up 48% of total net migration (interprovincial and international) to Alberta. Alberta had the largest number of interprovincial net migrants in Canada, followed by Nova Scotia. The origin and destination of interprovincial migrants are shown in Table 3 on the next page.

As shown in Table 3, the primary source of Alberta's interprovincial in-migrants for the second quarter was British Columbia, followed by Ontario and Saskatchewan. These three provinces were also the three main destinations of out-migrants from Alberta.

NATURAL INCREASE

Statistics Canada estimates that Alberta experienced a natural increase (births minus deaths) of about 5,300 people between April 1, 2003 and June 30, 2003. Almost 10,000 births occurred in this quarter, while there were an estimated 4,700 deaths.
