

Alberta Population Report

March 22, 2004

Fourth Quarter, 2003

POPULATION ESTIMATES

Alberta's population growth for the year 2003 continues to be the highest among the provinces. As of January 1, 2004, Alberta's population is estimated to be 3,172,121. This is an increase of about 40,000 persons (or 1.27% growth) for the year ending December 31, 2003. Ontario and British Columbia had the next largest growth rates among the provinces at 1.13% and 0.99% respectively.

The following table provides the January 1 population estimates and growth rates for Canada and Alberta since 1997.

Population estimates for January 1, 2004 for all provinces and territories are shown in Table 2 below. The annual population growth rates for the year 2003 are also included.

MIGRATION

For the fourth quarter of 2003 (October 1 to December 31), Alberta had an estimated net interprovincial migration of 1,800 people. This is about 50% of the total 3,700 net migrants (interprovincial plus international) to Alberta. During the fourth quarter, Alberta had the highest interprovincial net migration in Canada, followed by British Columbia. The origin and destination of interprovincial migrants are shown in Table 3 on the next page.

As shown in Table 3, the primary source of Alberta's interprovincial in-migrants for the fourth quarter was British Columbia, followed by Ontario and Saskatchewan. These three provinces were also the three main destinations of out-migrants from Alberta.

NATURAL INCREASE

During the fourth quarter (October 1 to December 31, 2003), Alberta gained 4,100 people in natural increase (births minus deaths). The province had 8,900 births and 4,800 deaths in this quarter.
