#### **POPULATION ESTIMATES**

Alberta's population growth between July 1, 2003 and 2004 remains the strongest among the provinces. As of July 1, 2004, Alberta's population was estimated to be 3,201,895. This represents a yearly increase of approximately 43,300 persons (or 1.37% growth) from July 1, 2003. Ontario and British Columbia had the next largest growth rates at 1.11% and 1.06% respectively.

The following chart shows both population estimates and growth rates of Canada and Alberta since 1998 for July 1.

Population estimates for July 1, 2004 for all provinces and territories are provided below in Table 2. The estimated growth rates for the twelve-month period ending July 1, 2004 are also included.

#### **MIGRATION**

During the second quarter of 2004, Alberta had an estimated total net migration of 6,400 people (4,000 international and 2,400 interprovincial). Alberta had the second largest number of interprovincial net migrants in Canada, next to British Columbia. The origin and destination of interprovincial migrants are shown in Table 3 on the next page.

As shown in Table 3, the primary source of Alberta's interprovincial in-migrants for the second quarter was British Columbia, followed by Ontario and Saskatchewan. These three provinces were also the three main destinations of out-migrants from Alberta.

#### NATURAL INCREASE

Between April 1 and June 30, 2004, Alberta experienced a natural increase (births minus deaths) of around 5,000 people. The province had approximately 10,000 births and 5,000 deaths during the second quarter of 2004.
