POPULATION ESTIMATES

The Alberta population growth between October 1, 2003 and 2004 continues to be the highest among the provinces. As of October 1, 2004, Alberta's population was estimated to be 3,212,813. This represents a yearly increase of approximately 42,600 persons (or 1.34% growth) from October 1, 2003. Ontario and British Columbia had the next largest growth rates at 1.14% and 1.10% respectively.

The following chart shows both population estimates and growth rates of Canada and Alberta since 1998 for October 1.

Population estimates for October 1, 2004 for all provinces and territories are provided below in Table 2. The estimated growth rates for the twelve-month period ending October 1, 2004 are also included.

MIGRATION

For the third quarter of 2004 (July-September), Alberta had an estimated total net migration of 5,200 people (3,300 international and 1,900 interprovincial). Alberta had the second largest number of interprovincial net migrants in Canada, next to British Columbia. The origin and destination of interprovincial migrants are presented in Table 3 on the next page.

As shown in Table 3, the primary source of Alberta's interprovincial in-migrants for the third quarter was British Columbia, followed by Ontario and Saskatchewan. These three provinces were also the three main destinations of out-migrants from Alberta.

NATURAL INCREASE

During the third quarter of 2004, Alberta experienced a natural increase (births minus deaths) of more than 5,700 people. Between July 1 and September 30, 2004, the province had approximately 10,400 births and 4,700 deaths.
