Mausoleum Approval

Definition:

A Mausoleum is a structure wholly or partly above the level of the ground and designed for the burial or storage of dead human bodies.

Only a religious auxiliary, religious denomination or a municipality may establish a new mausoleum.

Registration Requirements:

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Local Regional Health Authority approval. Regional Health Authorities may use their own forms or provide approval on health authority letterhead.
- 3. Municipal or regional planning approval, (may include development approval). Municipal or regional planning offices may use their own forms or provide approval by letter.

Additional Information:

A mausoleum only needs to register if the structure contains more than 12 compartments. It must be located in a registered cemetery.
