Notice to the Profession

May 1st, 2002

Part F. of the Consolidated Practice Directions of the Court of Appeal of Alberta is amended to include provisions 14 (a) and (b) which read as follows:

- 14.(a) “Where an application for leave to appeal has not been heard within 6 months from the date the notice of motion is filed, the motion will be deemed abandoned, unless otherwise ordered prior to the expiration of this 6 month period.”
- (b) “If the 6 month period for the hearing of an application for leave to appeal has expired as of the date of this amendment or will expire before July 2nd, 2002 the time period for the hearing of the application is extended to July 2nd, 2002. If the application has not been heard by that date, the motion will be deemed abandoned, unless otherwise ordered prior to that date.”

This amendment is effective forthwith.
