# Environmental Leadership Program

Everyone has a role to play in the health of our environment. Leading by example is the best way to encourage others to make a difference. The Government of Alberta strives to recognize facility operators who make the environment a priority in their work by going beyond the standards set out in their approvals. To this end, Alberta Environment has developed a stakeholder-reviewed, voluntary program called **EnviroVista**.

## Who is eligible for the program?

- Facilities with a current operating approval under *Alberta's Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*.
- Facilities that demonstrate environmental leadership qualities, backed by audited environmental programs.

## Levels of Recognition

- **Leader Level**  
This allows recipients to display a unique logo that identifies them as environmental leaders.
- **Champion Level**  
Alberta Environment will provide appropriate regulatory flexibility and other incentives to facilities that commit to achieve an even greater level of environmental performance through voluntary stewardship.
