Alberta's Unique Charitable Model

Alberta's unique charitable gaming model allows eligible charitable or religious organizations to conduct gaming events such as bingos, casinos, pull-ticket sales, and raffles. Proceeds from these activities support eligible community projects.

The Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC) has developed a training program to provide essential information to groups who conduct charitable gaming activities and to groups who may be interested in applying for a gaming licence.
