Electronic Disposition System

Introduction

Sustainable Resource Development (SRD) is proceeding with development of an electronic application submission system. This process will assist industry with submission of applications and reduce errors. This is the first step for an electronic application processing system and it will focus on the electronic submission of oil and gas applications to SRD. We are proceeding to add further components to provide more functionality for the system such as electronic referrals to our field offices. Some of these enhancements will be implemented later this year. As this system continues to be developed, it will enable SRD to move toward full electronic processing of applications.

Purpose

Alberta Sustainable Resource Development (SRD) will be implementing an online service that will allow clients to submit applications/amendments and associated documents such as consents, EFR, code of practice and plan packages for specified surface dispositions electronically. Specified purpose codes for LOC, MSL, PLA and PIL disposition types are included at this time.

The web service implementation of the Electronic Disposition System (EDS) is scheduled for June 5, 2006. EDS will allow clients to submit applications and amendments during extended hours. It will also provide validation of selected data fields at the client workstation thereby assisting the client to minimize the opportunity for errors on the submission.

There will be a one-month "grandfathering" period until July 4, 2006 for:

- Applications/amendments identified for submission through EDS (see note)
- Digital plans submitted to SRD prior to June 5, 2006. (Applications for these plans can only be submitted by paper)

Note: All digital plans submitted after June 5, 2006 must be processed through PCS and submitted through EDS.

Applications that are accepted by EDS will be assigned an activity number by EDS and emailed back to the client along with a copy of the application. This automated system will provide greater opportunity to ensure that industry clients continue to have efficient and consistent service.

Background

Alberta Sustainable Resource Development (SRD) is automating business processes for dispositions in order to respond effectively to the increasing numbers of applications by reducing application errors, reducing resources required to input data to LSAS and providing a web application for submissions.

The business process is presently completed in a manual mode with paper documents. The process will be developed in accordance with other SRD initiatives such as the Digital Integrated Dispositions (DIDs) and Digital Plan Submissions. The EDS will accommodate 85 percent of the estimated 20,000 applications submitted annually.

Procedure

All applications and amendments for dispositions identified for electronic submission must be submitted through EDS, effective July 4, 2006.

EDS will support the submission of a digital plan package (PDF, CAD, DDiPS files) for dispositions requiring digital plan submissions with paper applications or amendments. Dispositions requiring digital plans are listed in <u>Application/Amendment/Plan</u> <u>Formats Document</u> on SRD Website. Clients will need to acquire a GOA account and password in order to access the Plan Confirmation System and EDS. <u>The</u> <u>form</u> to acquire a GOA account and the <u>EDS Industry</u> <u>Client User Guide</u> are posted on the PLFD Website.
