






Familiarity With the Budget




Percent of Respondents who are Familiar



As you may know, on February 24, the Alberta Government released the latest provincial budget. How familiar are you with this recent budget?




Percent of Respondents who are **Satisfied**



Where Would You Go For Information on the Budget?




