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PREFACE

Supplementary Estimates for the General Revenue Fund are presented for the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner and fifteen departments of the Government of Alberta. The Legislative Assembly will be asked to appropriate spending authority from the General Revenue Fund, pursuant to the *Appropriation (Supplementary Supply) Act, 2003 (No. 2)*. These Supplementary Estimates reflect the same budgeting methodology as the 2003-04 Estimates which were tabled on April 8, 2003.

These Supplementary Estimates will authorize a \$1,228,295,000 increase in voted Operating Expense and Equipment / Inventory Purchases, and a \$21,040,000 increase in voted Capital Investment.

Definition of Terms:

Operating Expense and Equipment / Inventory Purchases. Operating expense consists of salaries, supplies and services, grants, amortization of equipment and capital assets, consumption of inventories and debt servicing costs. Equipment / inventory purchases consist of consumable inventories and movable capital assets, which are routinely moved or which may be installed as a service level improvement to existing facilities, as follows:

- i) regardless of value: assets such as mobile accommodation; mobile elevators; mobile equipment; tools; movable safety, recreation and rehabilitation equipment; attractive assets; appliances; display cases; furnishings; furniture; office equipment; shelving; and storage containers.
- ii) consumable inventories (only for the departments of Health and Wellness, Infrastructure, Sustainable Resource Development and Transportation).
- iii) projects and equipment costing less than \$5,000,000 over one or more years, such as scientific, medical, laboratory, information technology, communication and security systems and facilities.
- iv) vehicles.

Capital Investment consists of immovable capital assets, equipment required for their construction, equipment installed upon construction or replacement, renovations to immovable capital assets which extend their life and major scientific and information technology as follows:

- i) regardless of value: land; buildings; highways; roads; bridges; transportation and storage facilities; permanent accommodation; communications towers and other fixed devices; dams; water, sewage and disposal facilities; irrigation facilities; oil, gas and electricity transmission facilities; lighting and traffic facilities; elevators; ecological reserves, parks and sports facilities; heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems; laboratories; and construction projects.
- ii) regardless of value: capital equipment used in the construction of immovable capital assets, such as cranes, earth-moving equipment, tractors and conveyors.
- iii) projects and equipment costing more than \$5,000,000 over one or more years, such as major scientific, medical, laboratory, information technology, communications and security systems and facilities.

Adjusted Gross Amount includes amounts voted in the 2003-04 Estimates, reorganization changes and changes in expense authorized by section 24(2) of the *Financial Administration Act* for net budgeting.

Net budgeting provides a means of budgeting for goods and services which are subject to variable demand and for which a credit or recovery is received from external or internal sources. The Supplementary Estimates show the total gross amount, credit or recovery, and the net amount for net budgeted initiatives. If, during the fiscal year, expenses and credits or recoveries are both expected to exceed the amount budgeted, Treasury Board may increase the voted authorization pursuant to section 24(2) of the *Financial Administration Act*. If the budgeted credits or recoveries are not realized, the gross expense is managed so that it does not exceed the gross estimate less the shortfall in credits or recoveries.

REASON SUPPLEMENTARY ESTIMATE REQUESTED:

This Supplementary Estimate of \$728,821,000 is requested to provide:

- \$1,000,000 for Agriculture, Food and Rural Development's share of a market recovery strategy (*Economics and Competitiveness*);
- \$4,000,000 for the Stranded Beef Export Container Initiative (*Economics and Competitiveness*);
- \$6,000,000 for the Farm Water program (*Rural Services*);
- \$564,285,000 for Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) compensation programs (*Rural Services*);
- \$6,000,000 for the Grasshopper Control program (*Rural Services*);
- \$5,000,000 for Cull Cow and Bull Product Development (*Business and Innovation*);
- \$6,513,000 to support enhancements to Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies (TSE) testing and animal health surveillance (*Food Safety*);
- \$1,000,000 increase in provincial funding for Lending Assistance resulting from revisions to lending caps (*Agriculture Insurance and Lending Assistance*), and
- \$135,023,000 in provincial funding for the Canadian Agricultural Income Stabilization (CAIS) program resulting from the federal-provincial Agriculture Policy Framework agreement (*Agriculture Insurance and Lending Assistance*).

The total cost of disaster assistance is \$794,187,000, of which \$728,821,000 is to be voted by the Legislative Assembly and the remaining \$65,366,000 is a statutory expense. Pursuant to Section 4 of the *Fiscal Responsibility Act*, this disaster assistance will be funded from the Sustainability Fund.

The total cost of disaster assistance is offset by an increase of \$407,105,000 in federal transfers for agricultural programs.
