



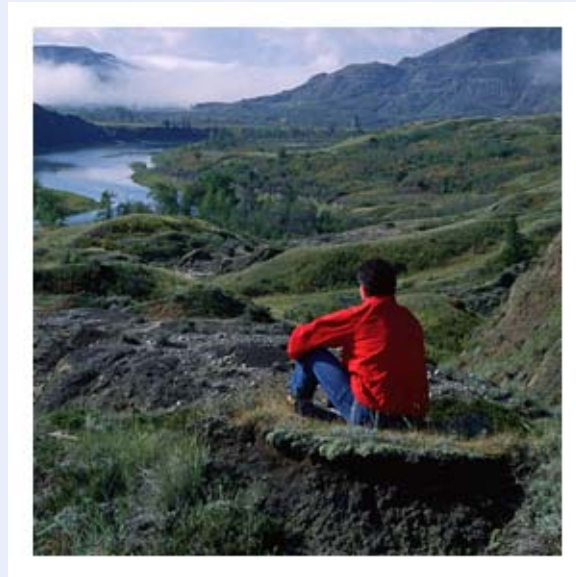

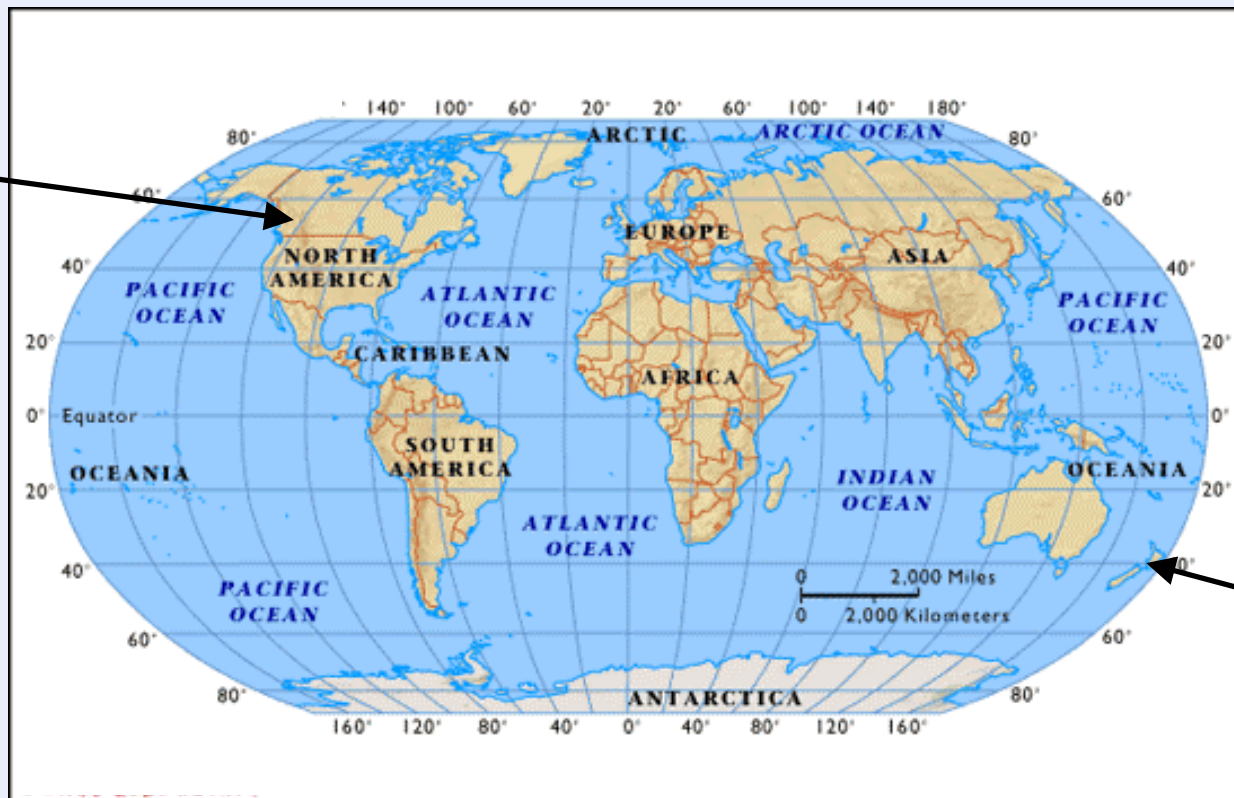

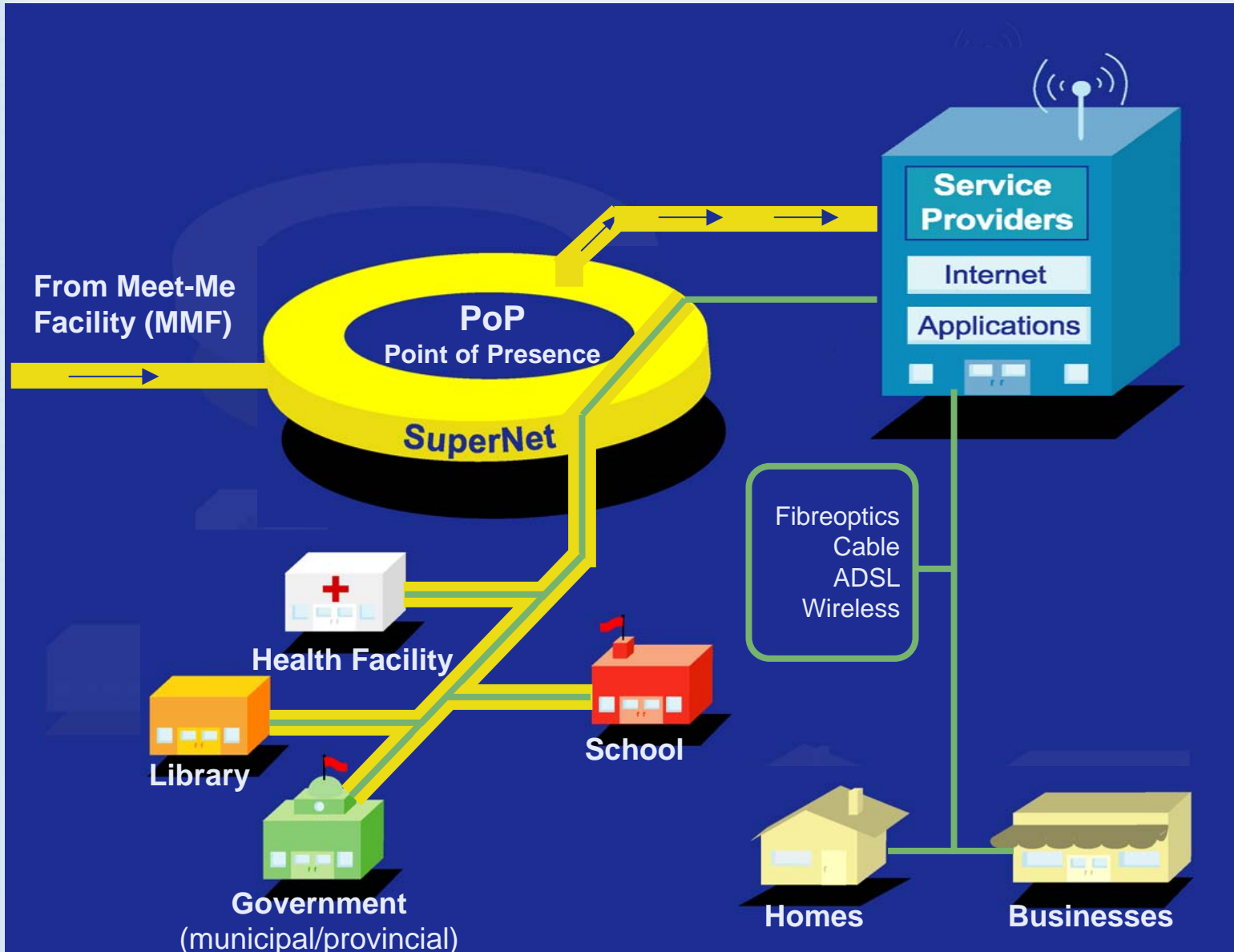
Did you know that Alberta SuperNet contains what is believed to be the longest wireless link of its kind? Can you guess what community required this long-distance wireless link?

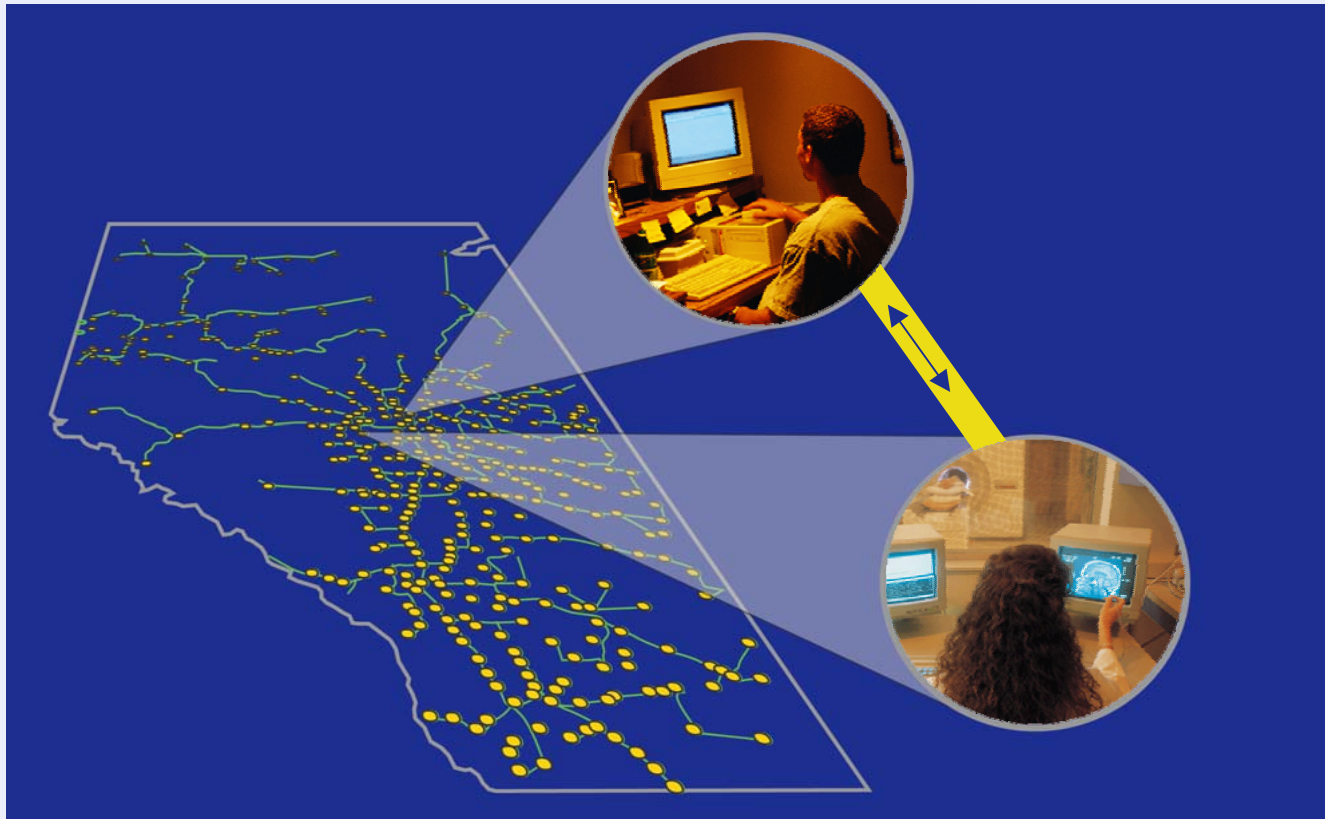

- Students in Red Deer and Rocky Mountain House are connecting in a collaborative, e-learning environment

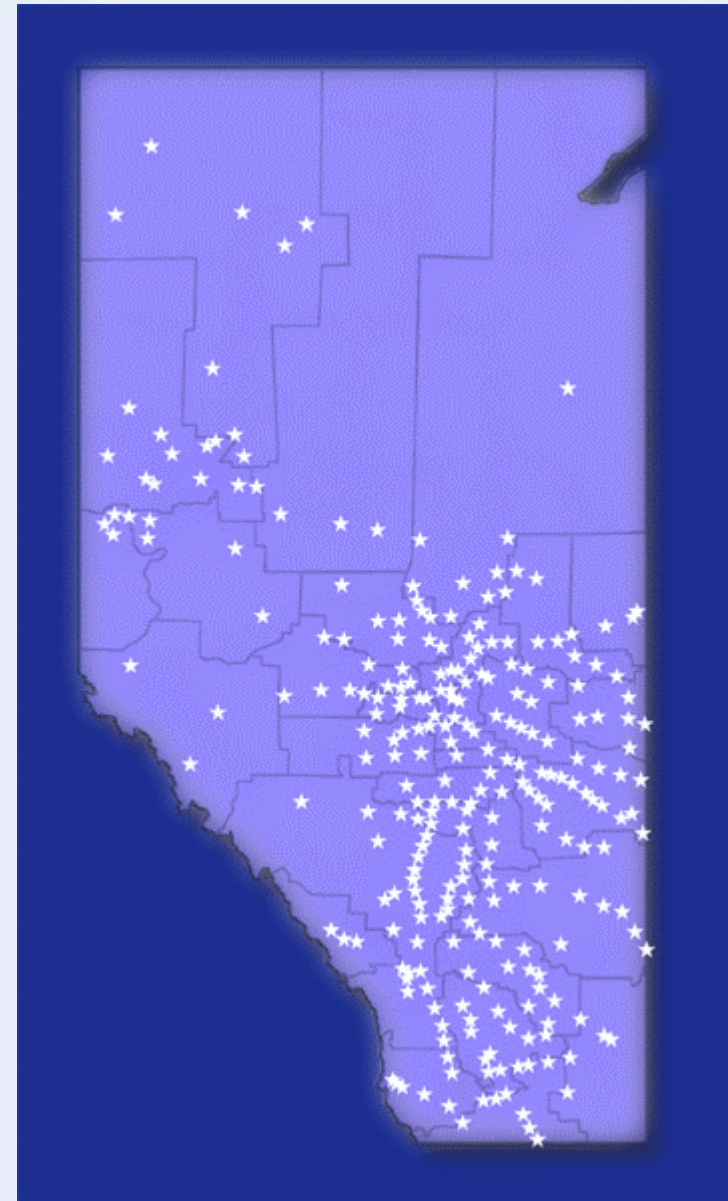
# E-Health



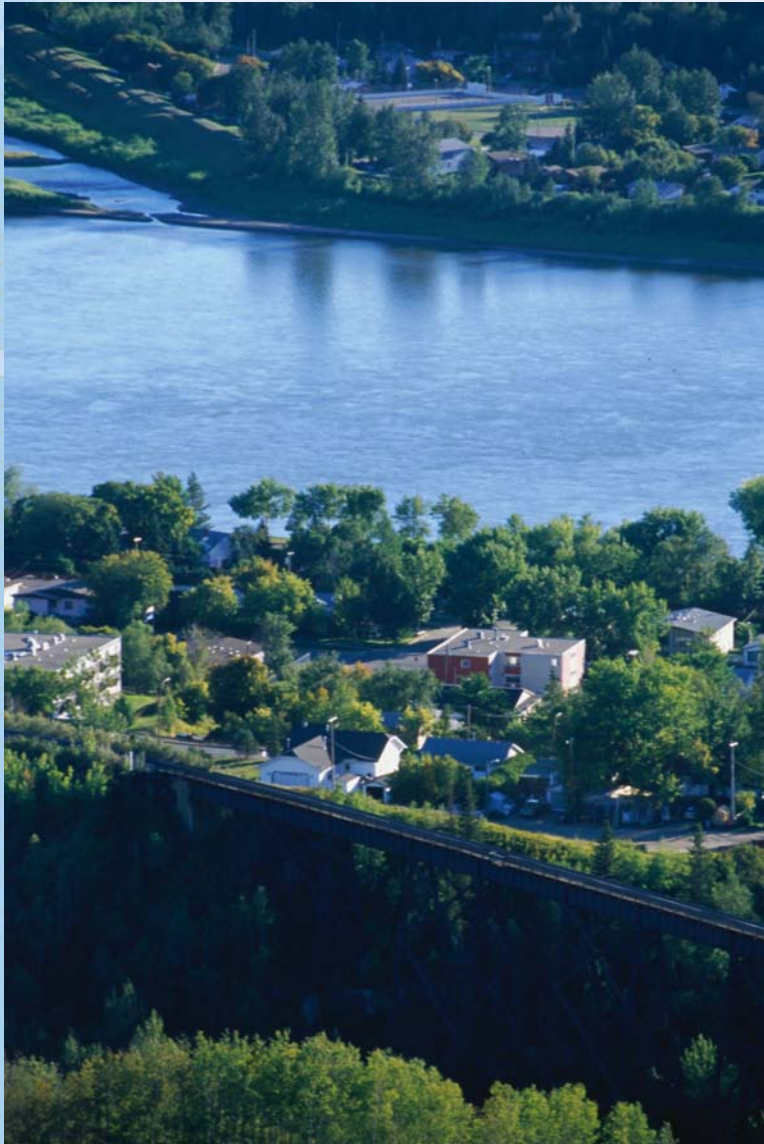
- Alberta SuperNet helps urban medical centres share information with rural specialists

- Alberta SuperNet helps provide rural access to the global marketplace

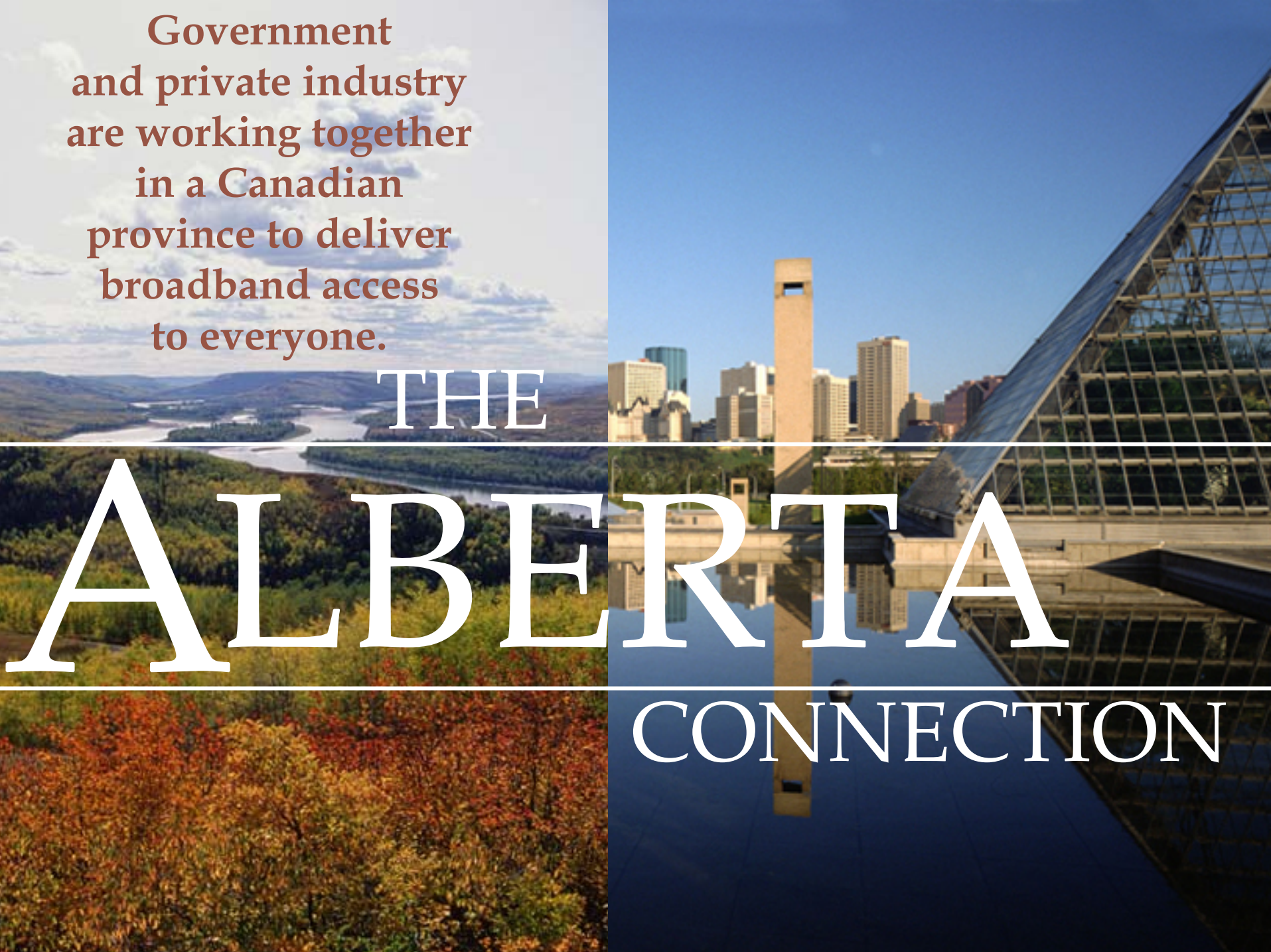

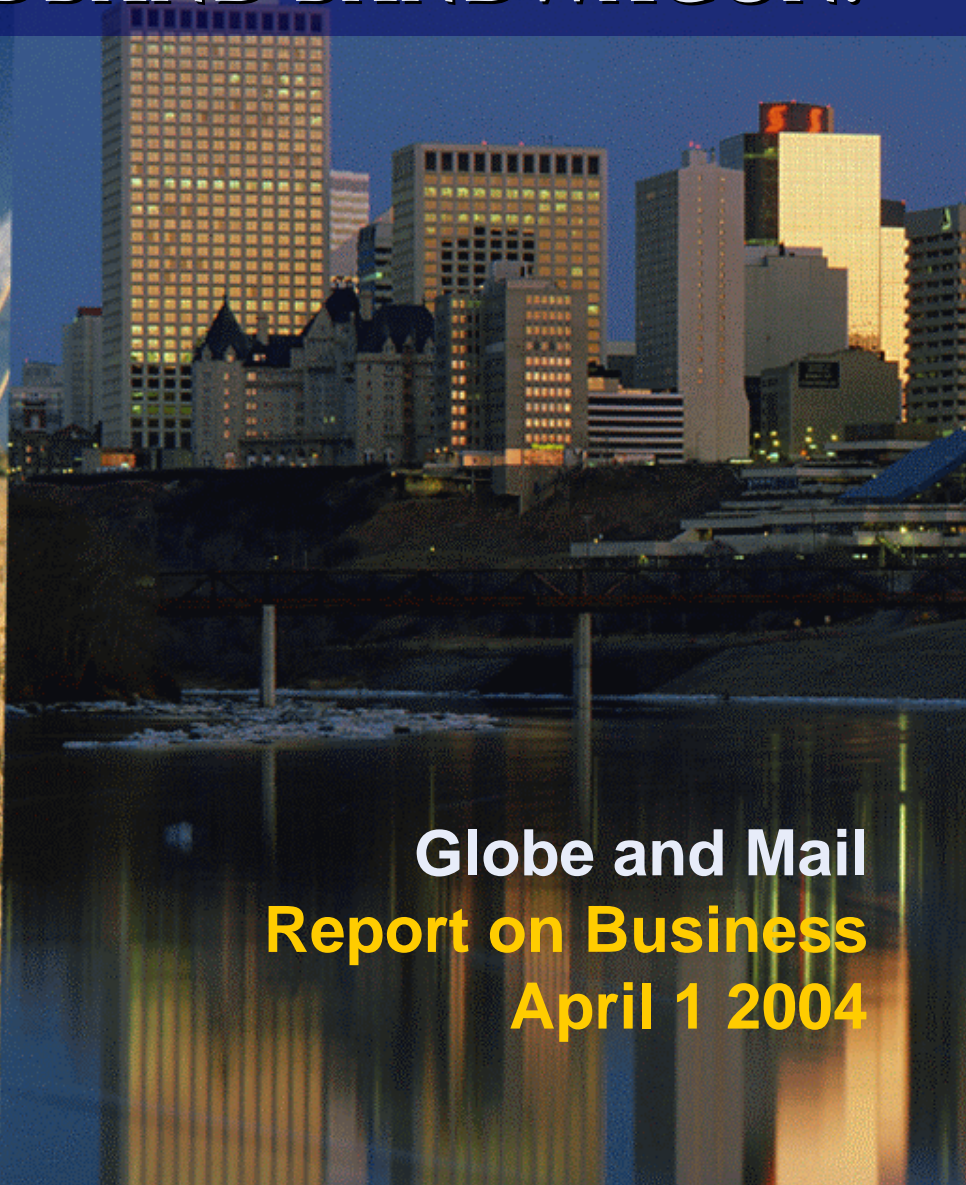
