The Workplace Health and Safety Contact Centre is a one-stop information shop about employees' and employers' safety obligations in the workplace.

The centre answers telephone and e-mail questions about how to deal with hazards in the workplace, what requirements are in place, and what assistance is available to help employers make their workplaces safer. Confidential services also enable workers to report unsafe working conditions.

Advisors who are able to address a broad range of questions and issues are available during regular business hours.(8:15 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays)

An answering service is available 24 hours a day for employers who need to report an accident.

Staff also reply to inquiries to a public e-mail address, **whs@gov.ab.ca**, which is listed on the department's website and in publications.

The Centre has taken about 25,000 calls a year in its first three years of operation.
