

First Nations Training to Employment Program

Program

Alberta Human Resources and Employment supports the development of partnerships between First Nations people, the private sector, industry, unions, training providers, the federal government and the provincial government. These partnerships help assist First Nations people to develop the necessary skills and knowledge to obtain and maintain employment.

The First Nations Training to Employment Program provides First Nations people (primarily living on-reserve) who are unemployed or underemployed with the skills needed for sustained employment in occupations with long-term employment prospects.

Services

The First Nations Training to Employment Program offers an array of projects that are economic and/or resource based. The elements of the program will reflect a holistic approach and will include, but are not limited to:

- life management and employment coping/job readiness skills
- employability skills
- work-related literacy skills
- specific occupation skills
- paid work experience or training on-the-job
- placement, follow-up and employment support
