Description

This one-day course (8:30 a.m.- 4:30 p.m.) is designed for management, supervisors and individuals that are involved in the health & safety coordination and claims/disability management within the organization.

Course Objectives

The objective of the 'Disability Management' seminar is to help employers understand the relationship between claims costs and WCB premiums, and how these can be managed through an effective disability management program. The overall result is reduced human and financial costs of workplace injuries.

1. Management Participation and Leadership
2. Pre-placement Screening
3. Injury Response, Reporting and Investigation
4. Case Coordination
5. Modified Work
6. Program Administration
