Purpose	Section 77(1) (a) (ii) of the Operator Licensing and Vehicle Control Regulation (OLVCR), AR 320/2002 provides the Registrar the authority to create special operating zones around Drumheller, Grande Cache, Crowsnest Pass, and Fort McMurray for any person who registers their vehicle with a Class 2 license plate. Special zone maps are required to define these zone boundaries.	
Principles	Persons registering a commercial vehicle with a Class 2 restricted license plate will be allowed to operate subject to Section 77 of the OLVCR or under the authority of a special permit.	
Criteria	<p>To be eligible to operate a vehicle registered with a Class 2 plate within the zones outlined: Schedule 1 - Drumheller, Schedule 2 - Crowsnest Pass, Schedule 3 - Fort McMurray, and Schedule 4 - Grande Cache a person must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have the postal address within that special zone boundary, • Have the postal address that is the person's residence or business address and, • Have the postal address that is displayed on the person's Certificate of Registration.
