Special: Seed Protectant Certification Class

The Recertification Program initiative for the Special Seed Protectant Certification Class has been determined by the Seed Protectant Certification Committee. The Committee is comprised of industry and government representatives and includes representatives from the Alberta Chapter of the <u>Canadian Seed Grower Association</u> and the <u>Association of Alberta Co-op Seed Cleaning Plants</u>. For more information on pesticide recertification, call 780-538-8054. The Committee has determined the following phase in for the seed protectant class:

- Applicators with certificates expiring in 2004 will renew by reapplying for their certificate. This option will only be offered until December 31, 2004 after which 5 credits will be required.
- Applicators with certificates expiring in 2005 will renew by rewriting the certification exam or obtaining 5 continuing education credits. The 5 credit option will only be offered until December 31, 2005 after which 10 credits will be required.
- Applicators with certificates expiring in 2006 will renew by rewriting the certification exam or obtaining 10 continuing education credits. The 10 credit option will only be offered until December 31, 2006 after which 15 credits will be required.
- Applicators with certificates expiring in 2007 will renew by rewriting the certification exam or obtaining 15 continuing education credits.
