

Special: Roots in Pipes Certification Class

The Recertification Program initiative for the Special: Roots in Pipes certification class has been determined. Applicators with certificates expiring in 2006 or later will renew by rewriting the certification exam or completing a Continuing Education Program. The Continuing Education Program involves obtaining six Continuing Education Credits related to the Core Lesson information* and completing the new "Roots in Pipes Recertification Homestudy Course"**. After both requirements are completed, recertification can be obtained by applying to Lakeland College for recertification.

* The six Continuing Education Credits related to the Core Lesson are available by attending a Pesticide Applicator Tutorial (first day only), the Authorized Assistant tutorials or a number of applicator recertification session (equal to 2 – Regulations, 2 – Health & Safety, 1 – Environment, 1 – Emergency Response concepts) offered by several colleges in Alberta. The Tutorial dates are listed below.

** The Roots in Pipes Recertification Homestudy Course (Lesson 804) is available from Lakeland College. Successful completion of the lesson along with obtaining 6 credits related to the Core Lesson will meet the Continuing Education requirements towards the Roots in Pipes recertification. The course can be ordered by calling Lakeland College at 1-866-853-8646. Applicators will have to complete and submit the course study guide to Lakeland College for marking. Credit will be assigned towards the Roots in Pipes recertification after the applicator has achieved a mark 80% or better on the study guide assignment.
