## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION – ALBERTA GOVERNMENT NATURAL GAS REBATE PROGRAM (NGRP)**

### **What is the rebate amount and rebate period?**

The Alberta Government 2006-07 NGRP (Standard Method) is available during the months of October 2006 through March 2007. Rebates will be paid if and when two of the three regulated gas companies serving the majority of Albertans (Direct Energy North, Direct Energy South, and AltaGas Utilities) are charging regulated rates of over \$5.50/gigajoule (GJ).

### **What are the Standard vs. Alternative Rebate Methods for Residential Consumers?**

You can only use one method in a rebate year; however, you may request to change the selected method on your application by writing the Program Office no later than August 31, 2007.

- **Standard Method:** All **eligible** Alberta consumers of propane, heating oil, or kerosene will receive, upon application approval, the rebates listed below on the full amount of their purchases in a month during those months when a natural gas rebate is in effect and paid.
- **Alternative Method:** All **eligible** Alberta **Residential** consumers of propane, heating oil, or kerosene will receive, upon application approval, a rebate on all deliveries made during the period of April 1, 2006 through March 31, 2007 calculated using the Annual Rebate Rate.

The amount of your rebate is determined by the natural gas rebate rate and your selected method. Refer to the Application Guide for more information on the two rebate methods:

<sup>1</sup> "+" means costs over \$12.00/GJ for natural gas, and in the case of propane, heating oil or kerosene, an additional amount per litre, as the case may be, calculated on a heat equivalent basis as determined by the Minister and based on the amount by which the Alberta price exceeds \$12.00/GJ.

### **What uses are eligible?**

All **propane, heating oil or kerosene** used for heating or operating residential dwellings including apartments, condominiums and rooming houses; farming operations; not for profits; municipal buildings, schools, universities, hospitals; industrial businesses excluding oil & gas industries; and non-industrial businesses will receive a rebate per litre purchased during a month in which a natural gas rebate has been declared. Industrial consumers' rebates will be limited to the volumes in the above table.

**Non-industrial** propane, heating oil or kerosene consumers may be entitled to an additional rebate for all consumption in excess of the monthly maximums by completing Section 4 of this Application Form.

### **What is not eligible?**

Consumption of **propane, heating oil or kerosene used:** outside Alberta; as an automotive fuel; in the exploration, production, processing, reprocessing, refining, upgrading, storage or transport of natural gas, petroleum or oil sands: or as a feedstock, is not eligible. Propane, heating oil or kerosene that is resold is also not eligible.

### **Where can I find more information about eligibility?**

### **Who needs to apply for the rebate?**

If you use **propane, heating oil, or kerosene** for eligible uses, and previously applied for the 2003-04, 2004-05 or 2005-06 NGRP, you will receive a *pre-filled* application form based on your previous application. If you have not received an invitation to apply, or if you did not previously apply to the program, you must complete an application form and send it to the address below.

### **How do I apply for a rebate?**

Please forward your completed application form, and if applying for cap removal, a copy of your *Alberta Workers' Compensation Board 2006 or 2007 Premium Rate Notice(s)*. We encourage you to submit your application form as soon as possible. You can then submit your receipts as you receive them, or you can send them all at one time. You will need to supply copies of your fuel purchase receipts in order to receive a rebate. **The deadline for submission of receipts is August 31, 2007.**

### **How will the rebate be paid?**

When an application is required for a rebate, the rebate will be paid by government cheque once receipts and other required information are received. Rebates may be paid to your supplier if your account is in arrears. Rebate cheques will be held until the rebate value reaches \$25.00 or more. Rebates of less than \$25.00 *may* be paid at the request of the applicant.
