

The following guidelines for the use of gaming proceeds for seniors social and recreational activities will apply:

1. **Seniors Entertainment**, provided:

- there is broad-based community involvement with activities not limited to the members of the licensed group;
- the majority of the senior group consists of individuals 60 years of age and older;
- any entertainment provided is for the seniors, not the general membership of the licensed group;
- no liquor is purchased from gaming proceeds; and
- the services paid from gaming proceeds are on a cost-recovery basis, and not intended to generate a profit. For example, the cost of the meal provided should be based on the actual food and labor costs, as well as a reasonable overhead to cover such things as the cost of utilities and supplies. It is expected the cost of such meals would be less than the regular menu charges.

2. **Travel**, provided:

- there is broad-based community involvement, and eligibility for the trips is not limited to the members of the licensed group.
- a minimum of 75% of those traveling consists of individuals 60 years of age or older; and
- expenses are restricted to direct transportation, meals, and accommodation costs within the province of Alberta.

3. **Veterans Benefits**, provided:

- all types of items to be distributed are clearly identified;
- all veterans benefit, not just licensee members;
- Description of circumstances in which an individual becomes eligible for benefits.
