- supporting nationally recognized charitable programs that benefit Albertans, such as the "Lions Eye Bank" and the Royal Canadian Legion's "Youth Polio Fund"; and
- supporting medical and educational research programs that may benefit all Canadians.

All out-of-Alberta but within Canada donations are limited to a maximum of 75% of gaming proceeds earned during the previous calendar year. A Request to Donate Proceeds Outside of Alberta but within Canada form must be completed and submitted for approval.
