

Background

The Public Health Appeal Board (The Board) was established February 03, 1999 under the amended *Alberta Public Health Act*. The new Public Health Appeal Board replaced the former Public Health Advisory and Appeal Board established in 1985.

The board is subject to general rules of administrative law and natural justice as they apply to quasi-judicial tribunals. Donald R. Cranston, Q.C., of the law firm Bennett Jones LLP provides the board with independent legal counsel.

Duties

The Public Health Appeal Board is a panel of not more than five members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The mandate of the Public Health Appeal Board is to hear appeals from individuals who have been directly affected by a decision of a regional health authority (RHA). Those decisions are related primarily to orders made pursuant to section 62 of the *Public Health Act*.

The board may call upon technical experts and professionals to assist and provide them with specific knowledge in areas related to the appeal. At the completion of the appeal, the board gives written notice of their decision. This may:

- confirm, reverse or vary the decision of the RHA or
- refer the matter back to the RHA for further consideration.

Appeal Activities and Summaries

The following is a summary of all appeals or applications received and/or heard by the Public Health Appeal Board from January 01, 2005 to December 31, 2005:

17/2004 (received 2004, disposition 2005)

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to ensure guard rails for all balconies are maintained in good repair and safe condition.

The appellants withdrew the appeal as the appeal was pending the decision of a previous appeal heard by the Public Health Appeal Board.

01/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to repair a number of conditions immediately.

The appellant withdrew the appeal.

02/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to repair a number of conditions within different timelines and to provide electrical power to occupied suites and common areas.

Hearing held March 9, 2005

The board reversed the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health with respect to the obligation to reinstate electrical power to the premises.

03/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to correct plumbing, electrical and various housing conditions of the premises.

Hearing held March 31, 2005

The board varied the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The appellant was granted an extension of time to correct the conditions as identified in the order.

04/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the housing premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held April 19, 2005

The board upheld the orders issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The appellant acknowledged the state of the premises and is to correct the conditions identified in the order to the satisfaction of an executive officer of Capital Health.

05/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to correct plumbing and sewage conditions of the premises.

Hearing held July 14, 2005

The board upheld the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The premises are to remain vacant until the appellant corrects the conditions identified in the order to the satisfaction of an executive officer of Capital Health.

06/2005

**Order issued by Executive Officer of David Thompson
Health Region**

Appeal of the rescinded order of an executive officer of David Thompson Health Region under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to repair a number of conditions by a specified time.

The file is closed as an appeal cannot be acknowledged from a rescinded order.

07/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act* and under the Food and Food Establishments Regulation, requiring the owner to allow the executive officer to inspect the premises for compliance with provincial statutes and/or Health Standards and to obtain license/permit to operate a semi-public swimming pool.

The appellant withdrew the appeal.

08/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the housing premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held July 13, 2005

The board upheld the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The premises are to remain vacant until the appellant corrects the conditions identified in the order to the satisfaction of an executive officer of Capital Health, including the provision of a professional engineering report regarding the foundation of the premises.

09/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the housing premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the owner to retain a professional engineer regarding the structural condition of the premises and to ensure the premises complies with all sections of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards.

Hearing held July 19, 2005

The board upheld the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The premises are to remain vacant until the appellant corrects the conditions identified in the order to the satisfaction of an executive officer of Capital Health, including the provision of a professional engineering report regarding the foundation of the premises.

10/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the housing premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

The appellant withdrew the appeal.

11/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the housing premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held July 14, 2005

The board upheld the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health with respect to the Order to Vacate the premises. The Unfit for Human Habitation order was not challenged.

12/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the housing premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held July 27, 2005

The Board sent the executive officer's orders back to the Capital Health Authority for further consideration and re-determination.

13/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of eviction notice. A review of our files indicates an executive officer issued an Order not permitting occupancy of the premises until authorized to do so by an executive officer of Capital Health.

The file is closed as the application for the appeal was not filed within the prescribed time requirements.

14/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Calgary Health Region

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Calgary Health Region under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

The file is closed as the appellants vacated the premises.

15/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to supply hot water and electricity and for the electric stove to be maintained in safe and proper operating condition.

Hearing held September 15, 2005 concurrent with Appeal 16/2005

The board upheld the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health.

16/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held September 15, 2005 concurrent with Appeal 15/2005

The board returned the order to Capital Health for further consideration and re-determination regarding further testing of the water.

17/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to conduct plumbing repairs and to repair water damaged areas in the hallway ceiling.

Hearing held September 14, 2005

The board reversed the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The appellant is to replace a portion of the ceiling drywall. The other conditions of the order remain in effect.

18/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, requiring the owner to repair a number of conditions by a specified date.

Hearing held September 16, 2005

The board varied the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The appellant is to have the premises cleaned by a person or company well informed of the proper procedure for handling potentially infectious materials.

19/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held October 20, 2005

The board upheld the Order to Vacate issued by the executive officer of Capital Health and varied the Unfit for Human Habitation Order by removing the appellant's name from the order.

20/2005

Order issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the order of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held November 2, 2005

The board upheld the order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health.

21/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Northern Lights Health Region

Appeal of two orders of an executive officer of Northern Lights Health Region under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held October 25, 2005

The board upheld the orders issued by the executive officer of Northern Lights Health Region.

22/2005

Orders issued by Executive Officer of Capital Health

Appeal of the orders of an executive officer of Capital Health under Section 62 of the *Public Health Act*, declaring the premises unfit for human habitation and requiring the occupants to vacate the premises.

Hearing held December 7, 2005

The board upheld the Unfit for Human Habitation Order issued by the executive officer of Capital Health. The appellant did not appeal the Order to Vacate as the tenants had vacated the premises.

Other Activities

Board members attended educational courses provided through **The Foundation of Administrative Justice**. These courses provide a valuable overview of essential practices and components of conducting administrative hearings. Attending courses of this nature enhance our ability to render fair and credible decisions.
