Coverage in the health plans will commence in the first full calendar month of employment or transfer into the plan. (Coverage will not be established retroactively when you transfer from another plan). If you commence on the first working day of the month, your coverage will be in place immediately and the applicable monthly premium will be deducted from your first month end salary.

If you commence on the second work day or later, your coverage will be in place the first of the next month and the applicable monthly premium will be deducted from your second month end salary.
