12 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• MMR<sup>2</sup></li> <li>• Varicella (Chickenpox)</li> </ul>
18 months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DTaP-IPV-Hib</li> <li>• Pneumococcal conjugate</li> </ul>
4 – 6 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DTaP-IPV<sup>3</sup></li> <li>• MMR</li> </ul>
Grade 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hepatitis B (3 doses)</li> <li>• Varicella<sup>4</sup> (Chickenpox)</li> </ul>
14 – 16 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• dTap<sup>5</sup></li> </ul>
