EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARDS PROGRAM

The Excellence in Teaching Awards (ETA) Program was initiated in 1989 by the Minister of Education and implemented by the Council on Alberta Teaching Standards to:

- recognize outstanding Alberta teachers
- honour creative, innovative and effective teaching
- focus public attention on the teaching profession and
- involve Albertans in celebrating teaching excellence

Over the years the ETA Program has been supported by a number of education stakeholder organizations as well as some businesses. Current supporters include: Alberta Home and School Councils Association, Alberta School Boards Association, Alberta Teachers' Association; Edmonton Journal, SMARTer Kids Foundation and Xerox.

The awards are presented by the Minister of Education at the Excellence in Teaching Awards Ceremony which is currently held in May of each year. In addition to the prestigious honour of being named a Provincial Award Recipient, each teacher receives a framed certificate and a commemorative lapel pin. A monetary award and a framed certificate are also presented to each recipient's school principal. In 1998 the ETA Program expanded to include additional awards for the innovative use of technology. Currently the SMARTer Kids Foundation presents the recipients of the Innovative Use of Technology Awards with a technology package. Since the inception of the ETA Program, over 7618 teachers have been nominated and 378 have been Award Recipients.

HOW TO nominate a teacher

for a 2007 Excellence in Teaching Award

IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ!

Designate a Nomination Co-ordinator. (This person can be you. You also can act as one of the four nominators required for each nomination.)

THE NOMINATION CO-ORDINATOR WILL:

- recommend for which award the individual will be nominated, an Excellence in Teaching Award, **OR** the SMARTer Kids Foundation Innovative Use of Technology Award;
- complete the Nomination Co-ordinator's form (FORM A); [DO NOT INCLUDE A STATEMENT OF SUPPORT]
- · distribute the other forms to the appropriate individuals;
- collect completed forms;
- place forms in the large brown envelope provided; and
- for those who download the nomination package from the website, you can place each form in a plain envelope and place all in a larger envelope.
- submit the nomination to the Selection Committee.

- the nomination is considered complete only if all forms (as noted above) have been received by the Selection Committee.
- a statement of support is required from the Principal (**must be on school letterhead**), Teacher Colleague, and a Member of the Public; OR if the nominee is a Principal, a statement of support is required from the Superintendent or designate, Teacher or Principal Colleague, and a Member of the Public.

- 3. Ensure that all nominators are:
 - aware for which award the individual is being nominated (an Excellence in Teaching Award, OR the SMARTer Kids Foundation Innovative Use of Technology Award); and
 - familiar with the selection criteria listed on the back of each form.
- 4. Distribute forms and envelopes to the appropriate individuals, each of whom is responsible for completing the appropriate form, writing a statement of support if necessary, and returning the submission to you in one of the envelopes provided.

A nominee must be an individual who:

- holds a permanent Alberta teaching certificate at the time of nomination; and
- taught courses of study and education programs (or supported the teaching of these) authorized by the School Act during the 2006-2007 school year; and
- works directly with students in a school setting on a daily basis (may be a principal or other certificated staff member).

NOTE

A finalist who was nominated for a 2004, 2005 or 2006 award is not eligible for nomination in 2007.

A Provincial Award Recipient or SMARTer Kids Foundation Award Recipient is not eligible for nomination.
