

Forest Protection Division AM Forecast Issued: Thursday, December 07, 2006

MPB Operations - Wilmore/Kakwa/Woodlands/Clear Hills/Spray Lakes Synopsis:

A mild westerly flow pattern covers all zones today which will allow very warm air to mix down to the surface. Temperatures will climb into the 5 to 10C range today once the winds begin to increase. The dry westerly flow pattern will continue well into the weekend.

Clear Hills: Winds becoming southwesterly 20 gusting 40 km/h with temperatures around 8C today. Temperatures will fall to around -5C overnight then rise into the 5C range on Friday. Similar temperatures and conditions are expected into the weekend.

Wilmore, Kakwa/Woodlands: Scattered to broken mid to high cloudiness today with temperatures between +8 to 10C. Winds increasing to southwesterly 30 to 40 km/h this afternoon which will mix the warm air down from aloft. Similar conditions for Friday and into the weekend.

Spray Lakes : Chinook cloudiness today with temperatures climbing to +7 to 10C range this afternoon. Winds will increase to westerly 40 to 60 km/h allowing for the warmer air aloft to mix down to the surface. On Friday, winds southwest 30 to 40 km/h with similar temperatures.
