### Waste Management:


The Town of Coaldale's Sewer System consists of 33 km of various pipeline sizes. Sewage enters into a sewer lift station and from there it gets pumped into a treatment facility. After being treated, the effluent is then used for irrigation purposes or is pumped into the river which is located 8 miles north of the Town limits.

Garbage for industrial and commercial users is collected twice weekly. Residential garbage is collected weekly.








### **Coaldale Family Expenditures (1996)**






