***definitions:**

Bulletin boards, also called newsgroups or discussion groups work in a similar way to electronic mail. Instead of writing messages to individual users, participants in bulletin boards post their messages on a news server. The messages are stored on the news server in hierarchical directories. Users participate in bulletin boards by reading the messages and responding to them. There are bulletin boards or newsgroups on virtually every subject you can think of.

A regular **electronic newsletter** intended for teachers.

Chat is real-time communication between multiple users over the Internet. Like a conference call using text instead of conversation. The text appears as it is typed on all PCs participating in the chat. Internet chat occurs in '**chat rooms**,' which are usually set up by specific sites for users with a common interest.
