

## Advance Payment Application for Former Students who resided at Indian Residential Schools 65 Years of Age or Older as of May 30, 2005

## Application must be received no later than December 31, 2006

Attached is the Application Form for the Advance Payment to former students who resided at Indian Residential Schools.

Only former students who resided at a listed Indian Residential School and who are 65 years of age or older as of May 30, 2005 are eligible for this Advance Payment of \$8000. That is, you must have turned 65 on or before May 30, 2005 to be eligible to apply for this Advance Payment. It is important for you to note that this payment is an <u>advance</u> and will be deducted from any common experience payment that may be offered at a later date or any future amount payable as a result of having resided at an Indian Residential School(s).

In order to receive this Advance Payment as quickly as possible, <u>you must provide</u> to the Government of Canada the following information and documentation:

## 1. Application Form:

A completed and signed copy of the attached Application Form including all of the information requested in the form.

#### 2. Proof of age document:

A certified true photocopy of your Birth Certificate **OR** of any 2 of the following documents: Certificate of Indian Status, Provincial/Territorial Driver's Licence, Provincial/Territorial Health Card or Canadian Passport as proof of age, in accordance with page 3 of the Application Form.

## 3. Certifying proof of age:

The photocopy of the proof of age document from #2 above must be certified by one of the people listed on page 3 of the application form, who must also sign and date the photocopy. The name, phone number, and position or title of the person who certifies the photocopy must be included, and they must write in Capitals on the photocopy: "I certify that this photocopy is a true copy of the original document which to the best of my knowledge has not been altered in any way."

Failure to accurately provide any of the above information or documentation could result in a delay in receiving the Advance Payment.

## **PROOF OF AGE AND IDENTITY REQUIREMENTS FOR QUESTION 3**

## **BIRTH DOCUMENTS**

- 1. You must be 65 years of age by May 30, 2005. That is, you must have turned 65 on or before May 30, 2005 to be eligible to apply for this advance payment.
- 2. You must submit a certified copy of your original Birth Certificate with your application form.
- 3. If you do not have an original birth certificate, you must submit a certified copy of two (2) of the following documents, one of which must have a photograph:
  - Certificate of Indian Status (issued by Indian and Northern Affairs Canada);
  - Provincial/Territorial Driver's Licence;
  - Provincial/Territorial Health Card;
  - Canadian Passport;

Please note that you cannot certify a copy of your own documents.

The following can certify your documents and must include their name, position and date certified on the certified copy. They also have to write in Capitals the following statement on the photocopy:

# I certify that this photocopy is a true copy of the original document which, to the best of my knowledge, has not been altered in any way.
