Investing in Infrastructure to Promote Growth and Economic Development

Guidelines for the NOHFC Infrastructure and Community Development Program have been enhanced such that some essential community infrastructure projects that improve “quality of life” are now potentially eligible.

- Essential community infrastructure projects which have the effect of improving quality of life for a broad number of community residents will now be considered.
- Eligible projects may now include such projects as arenas, community halls, multi-purpose community facilities, cultural facilities.
- Renovations or deferred maintenance projects, in addition to water, sewer, roads, bridges, airport, and waste disposal projects which do not demonstrate job creation or economic development benefits, will continue to be ineligible.
