

Labour Force Statistics Aboriginal People (Off-Reserve) June 2006

Alberta Highlights:

- The unemployment rate for Aboriginal people living off-reserve in June 2006 was 6.2% compared to 6.0% in May 2006. Alberta's unemployment rate was 3.4% in June 2006.
- For males, the unemployment rate was 6.1%, down 4.8 percentage points from one year ago. Females' unemployment rate was 6.2%, which was 1.0 percentage points lower over the same time period.
- In June 2006, the working age population, or those aged 15 years and over, was 95,300.
- The employment rate for Aboriginal people living off-reserve was 67.5%. By gender, the males' and females' rate were 71.0% and 64.3% respectively.
- Private sector employees accounted for 83.2% of total employees and public sector employees made up 16.8%.
