

DENTAL TECHNOLOGISTS

Dental technologists prepare and fabricate dentures and dental devices as prescribed by dentists. They are employed in dental laboratories.

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Grade X11 and successful completion of an accredited Dental Technology program or their equivalent is required. (Contact the Manitoba Dental Technologists Association for information on accredited programs).

WORK EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

A combination of six years of training and work experience in Dental Technology is required for certification as a Dental Technologist in Manitoba.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

To become registered as a Dental Technologist in the province of Manitoba an applicant must first complete the education and work experience requirements outlined above. They must then successfully complete the *RDT Certification Exam*.

To be eligible to write this examination, the applicant must apply to the **Manitoba Dental Technologists Association**. He/she must submit:

- original educational documents, diplomas or certificates;
- a completed *RDT Certification Examination* application form (available from the Manitoba Dental Technologists Association);
- verification of relevant work experience: and
- examination fee (\$75.00).
- * If documents are not in English, notarized translations are required.

When all education, examination, and work experience requirements have been successfully completed the applicant will be registered in the province of Manitoba as a Dental Technologist.
