TO

SOUTH SLAVE MÉTIS FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT

Dated August 29, 1996

AND

INTERIM MEASURES AGREEMENT

Dated June 22, 2002

Name change

Whereas a certificate was issued by the Registrar of Societies (Northwest Territories) on the 17th of July 2002 relating to the change of name of the South Slave Métis Tribal Council, a body corporate under the *Societies Act* of the Northwest Territories, to the Northwest Territory Métis Nation.

Therefore, the Parties agree that the name "South Slave Métis Tribal Council" is replaced by the name "Northwest Territory Métis Nation" in the *South Slave Métis Framework Agreement* of the 29th of August 1996 and the *Interim Measures Agreement* of the 22nd of June 2002.
