
Conducts public environmental reviews of development proposals on Crown lands, as referred by the Environmental Impact Screening Committee

Issues rights, leases, dispositions and authorizations on Crown lands issues land use permits in the Inuvialuit Settlement Region; responsi for benefit provisions, royalties, inspections and ministerial approval

Reviews proposals related to oil and gas exploration and development and pipelines, conducts environmental assessments, and issues authorizations and permits, and monitors for compliance, under the Fisheries Act, Oceans Act and Navigable Waters Protection Act.

Reviews, issues and enforces wildlife protected area and Ocean Disposal permitting; provides research and advice to support land claims and environmental assessments; ensures compliance under the Fisheries Act and is a Regulatory Authority under the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act.

Reviews proposed oil and gas developments to assess impacts on wildlife, wildlife harvesting, forest resources and community econo and social well being. Provides advice in these areas to authorities responsible for the environmental assessment and review process.
