





# Benefits of Reengineering Project

  - Greater productivity
















  - To improve service to our clients














# Revised Application Requirements

- Titles
- Drawings/Photographs
  - Size
  - Quality
  - Colour

## Titles – Greater Flexibility

- Common name generally known and used by the public
  - √ Acceptable title: 'Hammer'
  - Unacceptable title: 'Article for insertion of nails into wood or similar articles'
- Limited references to function and construction and to design features will be accepted provided that:
  - $\sqrt{\mbox{ The common name generally known and used by the public has been provided}$ 
    - Example: Acceptable 'Plastic Soap Dish', 'Wooden Chair'
  - ⊗ Not excessive or long-winded
    - Example: Unacceptable 'Rotatable collapsible steel seating device with wheels'
- Acronyms are acceptable
  - Examples: 'CD Holder', 'MP3 player', 'ATV'

## Drawings – Size, Quality and Colour

- √ Drawings/photos capable of being electronically scanned by the ID office
- √ Scanned images show design features clearly and accurately...

#### then, the ID Office will no longer raise objections to:


- Photographs smaller than minimum size requirement
- Mounted drawings or photographs
- Pencil drawings
- Colour drawings or photographs

## DesignPlus


- Modifications to DesignPlus to accommodate new workflows and work processes
- Public search screen now provides the ability to view application status













#### On-line Database


- Step 1: Scanning of registrations prior to June 2002
- Step 2: Indexing and link of data to DesignPlus
- Step 3: Partial online database (data from June 2002 to present)
- Step 4: Full online database
