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**EC1999-531****WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT  
REGULATIONS  
AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 21 September 1999.)

Pursuant to section 28 of the *Wildlife Conservation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-4.1, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Section 1 of The Wildlife Conservation Act Regulations (EC676/98) is amended by the addition of the following:**

(5) No person shall hunt waterfowl, including all ducks and geese, from within the boundaries of the right-of-way of any highway.

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**2. The regulations are amended by the addition of the following:**

5. (1) Every person who sets a trap designed to hold animals alive shall ensure the trap is checked at least once every day. Prohibition *re* live traps

(2) Every person who sets a trap designed to kill animals shall ensure the trap is checked at least once within the forty-eight hour period immediately subsequent to the time the trap was set or last checked. Prohibition *re* kill traps

**3. Section 47 of the Fish and Game Protection Act General Regulations (EC818/66) is revoked.****4. These regulations come into force on October 2, 1999.****EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** prohibits the hunting of waterfowl from within the boundaries of the right-of-way of any highway.

**SECTION 2** prescribes time frames for the checking of live and kill traps.

**SECTION 3** revokes section 47 of the Fish and Game Protection Act General Regulations.
