AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 28 November 2000.)

Pursuant to subsection 29(1) of the *Roads Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-15, Council made the following regulations:

1. Schedule C-2 (Paved Local (Class 2) Highways) of the Roads Act Highway Access Regulations (EC580/95) is amended by the addition of the following:

(264.1) Old Western Road RI11053. The paved portion of the Old Western Road commencing at the intersection with Maple Street (in the community of Tignish) and proceeding North for a distance of 0.19 km.

2. These regulations come into force on December 9, 2000.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations include a section of the Old Western Road, RI11053, in the listing under Schedule C-2, as well as an additional 100 metres, which was incorrectly omitted from the original regulations EC580/95.
