**PLANT HEALTH ACT**  
**POTATOES REGULATIONS**  
**AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 27 November 2001.)

Pursuant to section 6 of the *Plant Health Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-9.1, Council made the following regulations:

**1. (1) Clauses 1(c), (d), (k), and (l) of the Potatoes Regulations (EC138/95) are amended by the deletion of the words “seed potato regulations” and by the substitution of the words “Seed Potato Regulations”.**

**(2) Clause 1(m) of the regulations is revoked and the following substituted:**

(m) “Seed Potato Regulations” means sections 45 to 62 of the Seeds Regulations made under the *Seeds Act*, R.S.C. 1985, Chap. S-8; Seed Potato  
Regulations

**2. (1) Section 6.1 of the regulations is amended in clause 2(b) by the deletion of the words “certification number” and the substitution of the words “certificate number”.**

**(2) Section 6.2 of the regulations is amended in subsection (1) and in clause (3)(b), by the deletion of the words “certification number” and the substitution of the words “certificate number”.**

**3. Subsection 11.1(1) is amended by the deletion of the words “14(2), (2.1), (2.2) or (2.3)” and by the substitution of the word “17(1)”.**

**4. The regulations are amended by the addition of the heading “SEED POTATO TESTING” immediately preceding section 14.**

**5. Section 14 of the regulations is revoked and the following substituted:**

**14. (1) For the purposes of this section and sections 15 to 17,**

Definitions

post-harvest test	(a) “post-harvest test” means a laboratory test carried out on one or more samples of seed potatoes from a lot of seed potatoes, where such sample or samples are taken <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) at or after harvest, or</li> <li>(ii) in the field after complete vine desiccation,</li> </ul> for the purpose of determining the post-harvest test levels of each sample taken; and
post-harvest test level	(b) “post-harvest test level” means the percentage of seed potatoes that are infected with Potato Leaf Roll Virus or any of the strains of Potato Virus Y in a sample taken for a post-harvest test.
Persons who may collect samples	(2) The collection of a sample or samples of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test shall be either performed by or supervised by an inspector or officer, an inspector appointed pursuant to the Seeds Act (Canada) or any other person authorized by the Minister.
Size of sample	(3) The person performing or supervising the collection of a sample or samples pursuant to subsection (2) may determine the quantity of seed potatoes taken from each lot of seed potatoes as a sample for testing.
Application for collection of samples	(4) The Minister, on application by a grower or any other interested person, may direct a person referred to in subsection (2) to collect a sample or samples of seed potatoes from a lot of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test.
Applicant’s responsibilities	(5) The applicant requesting the collection of a sample or samples of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) is responsible           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) for having the post-harvest test performed on the samples collected, and</li> <li>(ii) for paying all expenses and costs related to the post-harvest test; and</li> </ul> </li> <li>(b) shall select, from among the laboratories accredited by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency to test for potato viruses, a laboratory to perform the post-harvest test.</li> </ul>

**6. The regulations are amended by the addition of the following:**

Determining test level for potatoes with two viruses	<b>15.</b> (1) For the purposes of determining the post-harvest test level of a sample of seed potatoes, any seed potato in the sample that is infected with two viruses shall be counted, by the laboratory which performs the test, as two infected potatoes.
Identification of result and provision of information	(2) The laboratory which performs a post-harvest test shall <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) identify the test results by the information on the statements attached, in accordance with subsection 16(3), to the containers holding the sample; and</li> </ul>

(b) provide a copy of all test results and any other information that is required by the Department, to the Department immediately on the completion of the post-harvest test.

**16.** (1) Where only one sample is taken from a lot of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test, that sample is deemed, for the purposes of these regulations, to be representative of the entire lot of seed potatoes.

Testing, one sample

(2) Where more than one sample is taken from a lot of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test, each sample is deemed, for the purposes of these regulations, to be representative of the part of the lot of seed potatoes that is taken from the same fields or parts or combinations thereof as the sample.

Testing, multiple samples

(3) An inspector, officer or other person referred to in subsection 14(2) who is collecting or supervising the collection of a sample or samples of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test shall

Identification of sample

(a) record

(i) the fields or parts or combinations thereof that each sample represents,

(ii) the certificate number of the lot of seed potatoes from which the sample or samples are taken, and

(iii) such additional information as the inspector, officer or other person considers appropriate for the purpose of identifying the sample;

(b) make and attach a statement, in a form approved by the Minister, containing the information referred to in clause (a) to any one or more of the containers holding the sample or samples; and

(c) give a copy of the statement prepared for each sample to the grower.

(4) Where more than one sample is taken from a lot of seed potatoes for a post-harvest test, the grower shall store each part of the lot represented by a sample in such a manner as to prevent it from being mixed with other parts of the lot and to preserve its identity.

Separation of lots

(5) Where a grower has more than one lot of seed potatoes from which samples are taken for post-harvest tests, the grower shall,

Storage requirements for multiple lots

(a) in respect of each lot from which a single sample is taken, store the lot in such a manner as to prevent it from being mixed with another lot, or parts of another lot, of seed potatoes and to preserve its identity; and

(b) in respect of each lot from which more than one sample is taken, store each part of the lot represented by a sample in such a manner

(i) as to prevent it from being mixed with another lot or parts of another lot, of seed potatoes, and

(ii) as is otherwise required by subsection (4).

- Mixed lots (6) Where, during storage or any handling or grading operation,  
 (a) two or more lots, or parts of different lots, of seed potatoes are mixed; or  
 (b) two or more parts of a lot of seed potatoes represented by different samples are mixed,  
 the lots, parts of different lots, or parts of a lot that have been mixed are deemed, for the purposes of section 17, to have the post-harvest test level that is the highest of the post-harvest test levels of the samples taken from any of the lots, parts of different lots, or parts of a lot that make up the mixture.
- Documentation required on sale (7) Where a grower sells a lot, or part of a lot, of seed potatoes for planting in the province on a farm unit other than the farm unit on which the seed potatoes were grown, the grower shall, before the seed potatoes are transported from any storage under the grower's control, give the purchaser the following documents:  
 (a) a copy of the post-harvest test results, from the laboratory which performed the testing, for each sample taken from the lot or part of a lot sold to the purchaser;  
 (b) a statement signed by the grower certifying  
 (i) the quantity of seed potatoes in the lot, or part of a lot, sold,  
 (ii) the identity of the lot, or part of a lot, sold by reference to the information recorded on each statement required to be given to the purchaser under clause (c); and  
 (c) a copy of each statement made under clause (3)(b) in respect of a sample taken from the lot or the part of a lot sold to the purchaser.
- Failure to provide documentation (8) Where a grower fails to give to the purchaser any of the documents, required by subsection (7), the lot or part of a lot of seed potatoes that are sold by the grower is deemed, for the purposes of section 17, not to have undergone a post-harvest test.
- Post-harvest test required **17.** (1) Subject to subsections (2), (3) and (4), every person growing more than 0.1 hectares, in total, of potatoes shall plant only seed potatoes that have undergone a post-harvest test and that have a post-harvest test level not exceeding 5.0%.
- Exception, Pre-Elite, Elite I (2) Seed potatoes of the Pre-Elite or Elite I class do not require a post-harvest test prior to planting if the seed potatoes are planted on the farm unit on which they were produced.
- Idem*, Nuclear class (3) Seed potatoes of the Nuclear class do not require a post-harvest test prior to planting.

(4) Any person registered as a potato breeder or potato evaluator pursuant to section 6.1 is exempted from the requirements of subsection (1) where the person grows potatoes on a farm unit under the person's own management. Exempted persons

**7. These regulations come into force on December 8, 2001.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** amends the definition and references to Seed Potato Regulations.

**SECTION 2** corrects references to "certification number".

**SECTION 3** removes references to replaced subsections in the old section 14.

**SECTION 4** adds a new heading.

**SECTIONS 5 and 6** amend the regulations by adding new definitions and specifying the information and procedure required for testing seed potatoes for levels of viruses.
