CHANGE OF NAME ACT
REGULATIONS

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 28 May 2002.)

Pursuant to section 16 of the *Change of Name Act* Stats. P.E.I. 1997, c.59, Council made the following regulations:

1. In these regulations, “confidential change of name” means a change of name carried out in a manner that avoids disclosing information concerning the change of name. “confidential change of name”

2. (1) An application for registration of a change of name pursuant to subsection 4(1) of the Act shall be made on Form 1 of the Schedule. Application
 - (2) An application made by a person jointly with a spouse to change the names of both spouses and the names of the children of either of them pursuant to subsection 4(2) of the Act shall be made on Form 2 of the Schedule. Joint application
 - (3) An application under section 5 of the Act shall be made on Form 3 of the Schedule. Minor or person in another person’s custody

3. (1) Written consent required by subsection 5(2) of the Act Consent
 - (a) on a joint application by spouses shall be made on Form 2 of the Schedule; and
 - (b) on an application concerning a minor or a person in another person’s lawful custody shall be made on Form 4 of the Schedule.

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 28 May 2002.)

Pursuant to section 18 of the *Companion Animal Protection Act* Stats. P.E.I. 2001, c.4, Council made the following regulations:

CODES AND MANUALS

- 2.** The following codes and manuals of animal care, maintenance, treatment and procedures, as amended from time to time, are incorporated by reference as part of these regulations for the purposes specified in these regulations: Incorporation of codes and manuals
- (a) the 2000 Report of the American Veterinary Medical Association Panel on Euthanasia, published in the Journal of the American Veterinary Medical Association, volume 218, number 5, March 1, 2001, p.669;
 - (b) the Guide to the Care and Use of Experimental Animals, published by the Canadian Council on Animal Care, volume 1 (2nd ed.) 1993 and volume 2, 1984, both as supplemented by policies and guidelines published and revised from time to time by the Canadian Council on Animal Care;
 - (c) A Code of Practice for Canadian Kennel Operations, published by the Canadian Veterinary Medical Association, 1994;
 - (d) the Animal Husbandry Manual, published by the Pet Industry Joint Advisory Council, 1987.

ACCEPTED ACTIVITIES

- 3.** A companion animal used for research or teaching must be kept in accordance with the standards of care, maintenance and treatment set out in the Guide. Description of designated activities -research and teaching
- 4.** Euthanasia of a companion animal must be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in either the Report or the Guide. Euthanasia

COMPANION ANIMAL ESTABLISHMENTS

- 5.** The licensee of a companion animal establishment at which cats and dogs are housed shall ensure that Cats and dogs
- (a) the companion animal establishment is constructed in accordance with the standards for constructions set out in the Code; and
 - (b) the cats and dogs kept in the companion animal establishment are provided with the standards of animal care, maintenance and treatment set out in the Code.
- (2) The licensee of a companion animal establishment shall ensure that companion animals, other than cats and dogs, are provided with the standards of animal care, maintenance and treatment set out in the Manual. Other animals

RECOVERY OF AN ANIMAL WITH THE SOCIETY

13. (1) For the purposes of subsection 9.1(1) of the Act, a companion animal placed in the possession and charge of the Society may be recovered in accordance with the Act and these regulations within seven days of the day the animal was caught or removed, as the case may be.

Seven days to recover

(2) Where a companion animal placed in the possession and charge of the Society is under observation for rabies, it may be kept by the Society until released by a veterinarian, and the time for the recovery of the animal under subsection (1) runs from the day the animal is released.

Exception - rabies

(3) Where a companion animal is placed in the possession and charge of the Society after being removed pursuant to clause 9(2)(b) of the Act, because an order has not been complied with, the animal shall be kept by the Society until the order is complied with, as determined by an inspector or officer, and the time for the recovery of the animal under subsection (1) runs from the earlier of

Exception - non-compliance with order

- (a) the day the order is complied with; and
- (b) two weeks after the day the animal was removed.

LICENSE APPLICATIONS

14. For the purposes of clause 10.2(1)(a) of the Act, a license application shall include the following information respecting the companion animal establishment for which the application is made:

Required information

- (a) the name of the companion animal establishment;
- (b) the location of the companion animal establishment;
- (c) the name of the owner of the companion animal establishment and the person, if any, operating the companion animal establishment for the owner;

EXPLANATORY NOTES

These regulations adopt certain codes and manuals respecting the standards of care of animals and explain the circumstances which these standards apply. These regulations also prohibit certain activities respecting companion animals and require certain information to be included in an order made under the *Companion Animal Protection Act*. Finally, these regulations provide a time period for the recovery of an animal placed with the Humane Society and set out the amounts of certain fees that are payable.
