**HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT**  
**DEALER'S LICENSE REGULATIONS**  
**AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 17 September 2002.)

Pursuant to section 51 of the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Section 1 of the *Highway Traffic Act Dealer's Trade License Regulations (EC317/92)* is amended**

**(a) in clause (b), by the addition of the word "issued" after the words "dealer's trade license";**

**(b) by the deletion of the period after clause (b) and the substitution of a semicolon; and**

**(c) by the addition of the following:**

(c) "off-highway vehicle" means an off-highway vehicle as defined off-highway vehicle in section 1 of the *Off-Highway Vehicle Act*.

**2. Section 2 of the regulations is amended**

**(a) by the deletion of the word "four" in the words preceding clause (a) and by the substitution of the word "five";**

**(b) by the deletion of the word "and" after clause (c);**

**(c) by the revocation of clause (d) and the substitution of the following:**

(d) Class D license is a license issued to a person who

- (i) subject to subclause (ii), deals only in new and used motor homes, trailers or motorcycles,
- (ii) on an occasional basis, accepts a motor vehicle as a trade-in and resells such a motor vehicle, and
- (iii) maintains an established place of business within this province in connection therewith;

**(d) by the addition of the following:**

(e) Class E license is a license issued to a person who

- (i) subject to subclause (ii), deals only in new and used off-highway vehicles,

- (ii) on an occasional basis, accepts a motor vehicle as a trade-in and resells such a motor vehicle, and
- (iii) maintains an established place of business within this province in connection therewith.

### **3. Section 4 of the regulations is amended**

**(a) by renumbering the section as subsection (1); and**

**(b) by the addition of the following:**

Established place of business (2) On issuing or renewing a license, the Registrar shall note on the license, and keep a record of the location of, the dealer's established place of business.

Amending license (3) Where the established place of business of a dealer changes during the term of a license, the Registrar shall, on application by the dealer, issue the dealer with an amended license that reflects the change.

Refusal to renew license (4) On an application to renew a license, the Registrar may refuse to renew the license where the Registrar is satisfied that, during the previous 12 months, the applicant

(a) displayed a vehicle for sale at a place which at the time of the display was not the established place of business noted on the licence then held by the applicant; or

(b) failed, for any period of time that the Registrar considers significant, to maintain the established place of business noted on the licence then held by the applicant.

### **4. Subsection 6(1) of the regulations is amended by the deletion of the words "\$5,000" and the substitution of the words "\$15,000".**

### **5. Form 1 of the Schedule to the regulations is amended**

**(a) by the deletion of the words "Amount \$5,000" and the substitution of the words "Amount \$15,000"; and**

**(b) by the deletion of the words "FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000)" and the substitution of the words "FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000)".**

**6. For greater certainty, a dealer who holds a dealer's trade license on the coming into force of these regulations is not required to furnish a new security bond in the amount of \$15,000 until the dealer applies to renew the dealer's trade license.**

**7. These regulations come into force on September 28, 2002.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

These amendments add a new class of license for dealers of off-highway vehicles and require the Registrar to record a dealer's established place of business on the dealer's license. These amendments also permit the Registrar to refuse to renew a dealer's trade license where the dealer displays a vehicle for sale in a location other than that recorded on the dealer's trade license, or where the dealer fails to maintain the established place of business. Finally, these amendments change the amount required for a security bond from \$5,000 to \$15,000.

Pursuant to section 65 of the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5, Council made the following regulations:

**1. The *Highway Traffic Act* Fees Regulations (EC309/93) are amended in Table 1 in respect of the entry relating to a dealer's plate by the deletion of the words "\$68" and the substitution of the words "\$80".**

**2. The regulations are amended in Table 4 in respect of the entry relating to a dealer's trade licence**

**(a) by the deletion of the word "75"; and**

**(b) by the addition of the following, in columns 1 and 2, immediately below the words "Dealer's trade license":**

(a) initial licence	250
(b) renewal	150
(c) reinstatement of license after suspension or cancellation	250

**3. These regulations come into force on September 28, 2002.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

These amendments increase the annual registration fees in respect of a dealer's plate and set out additional fees in respect of a dealer's trade license.

**ROADS ACT  
HIGHWAY ACCESS REGULATIONS  
AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 17 September 2002.)

Pursuant to subsection 29(1) of the *Roads Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-15, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Schedule C-3, LOCAL (CLASS 3) HIGHWAYS, of the *Roads Act Highway Access Regulations (EC580/95)* is amended by the addition of the following:**

(69.1) **Route 249 Quinn Road:** The unpaved portion of the Quinn Road in the settlement of Kingston, commencing 450 metres from the intersection of Route 235 for a distance of 0.75 km.

**2. Schedule D, SEASONAL HIGHWAYS, of the regulations is amended by the revocation of clause (35) and the substitution of the following:**

(35) **Route 249 Quinn Road:** The Quinn Road in the settlements of Green Bay and Kingston commencing at a distance of 1.2 km from the intersection of Route 235 to the intersection of Route 244, a distance of 1.4 km.

**3. These regulations come into force on September 28, 2002.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

The amendments

- (a) classify 0.75 km of the unpaved portion of Route 249 in the settlement of Kingston as a C-3 unpaved local road, to enable the Department of Transportation and Public Works to provide year-round maintenance to it, and
- (b) classify 1.4 km of the Quinn Road as a seasonal highway.
